B. Fresno County Transportation Authority (FCTA) Measure C Allocation FY 2021-22 [APPROVE]

Summary: The estimated FCTA Measure C allocation of \$3,481,583 will be used in the FY 2021-22 FCRTA annual budget for operations and capital expenses. The FCTA Measure C Certification and Claim Form is attached for your review **(ATTACHMENT)**.

C. Request for Qualification (RFQ) Fleet Maintenance Facility Project [INFORMATION]

Summary: FCRTA released a Request for Qualification (RFQ) on June 30th for the design and construction of the Fleet Maintenance Facility. FCRTA is soliciting Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) from DB Entities in order to solicit information in the form of a qualification questionnaire and qualification statements. All Entities that intend to submit a proposal for the project must fully complete the SOQ package and provide all materials requested in the RFQ. FCRTA intends to create a short-list of up to the three of the most highly qualified Entities and the short-listed Entities will be issued a Request for Proposals (RFP). Following receipt of Proposals, FCRTA will select the proposal that FCRTA determines to provide the best value, based on qualifications and other factors that will be set forth in the RFP. It is FCRTA's intent to award a single contract to a selected DB Entity to deliver this project. Proposals are due and must be received at the FCRTA office at 2035 Tulare Street, Suite 201, Fresno, CA 93721 by 4:30PM on Friday, July 30th.

D. National Interstate Insurance Renewal [INFORMATION]

<u>Summary:</u> FCRTA has renewed insurance with National Interstate to cover property and vehicles currently operated by FCRTA. FCRTA currently has 6 vehicles covered by National Interstate. We experienced an increase on the 6 vehicles with National Interstate due to our previous service providers safety/accident and claims record. The remaining 114 vehicles are covered by the subcontractor MV Transportation's insurance. Other annual insurance coverage for FCRTA through FY 2021-22 includes vehicle, excess policy, property, general liability and DOE.

E. Volkswagen Environmental Mitigation Trust Funds Grant Application [APPROVE]

Summary: FCRTA is submitting an application to the Volkswagen Environmental Mitigation Trust Funds Grant Program for five (5) 23-foot BYD electric buses to be deployed on the existing demand response and fixed route transit services. This project mitigates excess NOx emissions, reduces pollution in disadvantaged and low-income communities, supports advanced technology vehicle and equipment deployments and accelerates the zero-emission transformation of the FCRTA fleet.

F. Areas of Persistent Poverty Grant Application [APPROVE]

<u>Summary:</u> FCRTA is submitting an application to the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Areas of Persistent Poverty Grant Program in the amount of \$170,000. This grant program provides funding for projects that help lift communities out of poverty by supporting transit service improvements in underserved communities. FCRTA is proposing a comprehensive study to expand existing on-demand electric vehicle micro-transit service. The proposed study will analyze service to the unincorporated communities in rural Fresno County providing essential connections to the adjacent incorporated cities and the Fresno Clovis Metropolitan area.

G. Caltrans Sustainable Communities Planning Grant [APPROVE]

WHEREAS, claimant has segregated property tax revenues from claimant's other general fund revenues used to support the Regional Public Transit Program, Public Transit Agencies – FCRTA sub program funds so that verification of non-substitution can be proved through audit or that the non-substitution of funds shall apply to claimant's general fund, and

WHEREAS, claimant shall account for the Regional Public Transit Program, Public Transit Agencies – FCRTA sub program funds received pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 142257. Claimant shall maintain current records in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, and shall separately record expenditures for each type of eligible purpose. Claimant shall make such records available to the Authority for inspection or audit at any time.

WHEREAS, claimant shall complete the reporting requirements no later than November 15, 2021 for the FCRTA's Measure "C" Programs.
