

RFP Transit Feasibility Study | Written Questions & Answers

- Can the acknowledgements/disclosures mentioned in Sections G (Insurance), I (Conflicts of Interest), and K (Signing/Authorization) be included in the letter of transmittal or are they required as separate sections?

Letter of transmittal may be included in the proposal, however FCRTA recommends including as separate sections to allow the scoring panel to reference.

- Please confirm our assumption that resumes should be provided in Section J as described in the RFP (contrary to Section E which refers to an “appendix” for resumes).

Yes, please provide resumes for the proposed project team.

- Please confirm our assumption that proposed detailed cost detailed info and summary will be provided in Section F as described in the RFP and that the “Budget and Cost Schedule Template” in Attachment C will be filled out separately with consistent information in Section L.

The cost not to exceed for this project was provided in Appendix B in the amount of \$274,299. Please provide a budget and cost schedule in your proposal, a template was provided in Attachment C.

- Please confirm our assumption that the Consultant/Proposer is responsible for Tasks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 in the RFP and not Task 01 or 02 in the Appendix A Scope of Work.

Yes, consultant will be responsible for Tasks- 1-6 and FCRTA will be responsible for Tasks 01 and 02.
