AMENDMENT VI TO THE AGREEMENT FOR CONTRACTOR SERVICES BETWEEN THE FRESNO COUNTY RURAL TRANSIT AGENCY AND WALKER CONSULTANTS

This Amendment VI to Agreement for Contractor Services ("Amendment VI") amends that certain Agreement for Contractor Services entered into on October 30, 2020, as has been amended from time to time (collectively, "Agreement"), between the FRESNO COUNTY RURAL TRANSIT AGENCY ("FCRTA") and WALKER CONSULTANTS, ("CONTRACTOR"). FCRTA and CONTRACTOR may be referred to herein collectively as the "Parties" or individually as a "Party."

Whereas, under the Agreement, CONTRACTOR agreed to provide contractor services to FCRTA;

Whereas, the Agreement, as amended, is set to expire on June 30, 2025;

Whereas, the Parties wish to extend the term of the Agreement by one year; and

Whereas, an amendment to the Agreement is necessary to extend the agreement into the next fiscal year and to increase the maximum compensation payable under the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration for their mutual promises, FCRTA and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

1. That existing Section III. A. TOTAL COMPENSATION: shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Notwithstanding any other provision in this Agreement, the basic fee for the services rendered shall be computed at the hourly and cost rates as set forth in Exhibit A (CONTRACTOR's Scope of Work & Project Timeline),and shall be limited by an amount not to exceed the sum of \$60,000.00.

2. That existing Section XIII. EFFECTIVE DATE, TERM: shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

This Agreement shall become effective as of the date of its execution by the parties hereto and shall remain in full force and effect through June 30, 2026 unless sooner terminated or unless its term is extended. Upon the mutual written Agreement of the parties hereto, this Agreement may be extended beyond that date.

- 3. This Amendment VI to Agreement shall become effective on June 27, 2025 ("Effective Date").
- 4. Upon the Effective Date, the Agreement, inclusive of all previous amendments, and this Amendment VI shall together constitute the Agreement.

- 5. Unless expressly modified by the terms of this Amendment VI, all terms of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
- 6. Each Party represents and warrants to the other Party that such Party is duly authorized and empowered to execute, enter into, and perform its obligations set forth in this Amendment VI, and that the individual signing this Amendment VI on behalf of such Party has been duly authorized to execute this Amendment VI on behalf of such Party, and will, by signing this Amendment VI on such Party's behalf, legally bind such Party to the terms, covenants, and conditions of this Amendment VI. Each Party further represents and warrants to the other Party that no other person or entity is required to give its approval or consent to this Amendment VI in order for such Party to authorize, enter into, and perform its obligations under this Amendment VI, or that if such approval or consent to this Amendment VI is required, that such approval or consent has been obtained.

- Contractor will provide assistance with transit planning, policy, analysis and evaluation on existing FCRTA projects and service.
- Contractor will provide technical assistance with development and implementation on future FCRTA grant projects that include transit planning, policy, analysis, and evalution.
- Contractor will provide technical assistance with development and implementation on future FCRTA grant projects that include outreach and engagement.
- Contractor will perform various research, data analysis, budgetary analysis, program analysis and computer research functions to support FCRTA's projects.
- Contractor will create various data and research material to support FCRTA's grant projects including; service planning and analysis, evaluation and monitoring, and community meeting support as required by funding sources prior to submittal.
- Contractor will evaluate and assist in microtransit projects.
