B. Request for Proposals Microgrid Phase 2 Project [INFORMATION]

Summary: FCRTA was awarded \$698,000 in funding through the Caltrans Sustainable Communities Transportation Planning Grant Program. The project includes a microgrid feasibility study phase 2. A kick-off meeting with Caltrans and FCRTA took place in December to discuss grant procedures and project details. As indicated in the grant application, FCRTA will be utilizing a qualified consulting firm to perform this study and complete a Request for Proposal (RFP) process for selection of a consulting firm. The intent of this RFP is to retain a consultant to; evaluate the feasibility of distributed energy resources such as microgrids and other affordable charging model technologies for use in Fresno County, expand the scope of FCRTA's microgrid initiative and seek partnerships with school districts in rural Fresno County for microgrids at school district properties, maximize FCRTA's microgrid investment by evaluating charging infrastructure for FCRTA and the schools, and school districts, determine how microgrids can provide backup power for critical infrastructure on school properties, and develop an actionable implementation plan for microgrid installation on school properties. The RFP will be released on January 12, 2026, and proposals are due on February 18, 2026. Staff will return to the Board with a proposed consultant and agreement for approval. The RFP will be available once released at the FCRTA website www.ruraltransit.org.
